Milverton Family Fun Fair Saturday May 11, 2019, @ The MAC

Class 1: Junior Fair - Ages 3 and Under (age as of May 11, 2019)

Please include age on entry tag. No entry fee is required to enter this class. Entries must be the work of the exhibitor and done within the last calendar year.

Section:

1. In a zippered bag, place 3 different stones found on a nature walk
2. Print and colour a colouring picture of a rabbit
3. On a 8.5" x 11" piece of paper, make a pattern using stickers
4. Make a bead necklace



Prizes: 1st - \$4.00, 2nd - \$3.00, 3rd - \$2.00

Class 2: Junior Fair - Ages 4-6 (age as of May 11, 2019)

Please include age on entry tag. No entry fee is required to enter this class. Entries must be the work of the exhibitor and done within the last calendar year.

Section:

1. On a paper plate, display 3 items found on a nature walk
2. Trace your hand on a piece of paper (8.5" x 11") and make a finger farm
3. Print and colour a picture of a Magician or Wizard
4. Create an egg carton caterpillar
5. Print the words "Do you believe in magic?"
6. Make anything from a deck of playing cards (does not have to be a whole deck)
7. Perth County Farm Safety Association Special: Cut and paste on an 8.5" x 11" paper a picture of a tractor, below print the words "stay safe"

Class 3: Junior Fair - Ages 7-9 (Age as of May 11, 2019)

Please include age on entry tag. No entry fee is required to enter this class. Entries must be the work of the exhibitor and done within the last calendar year.

Section:

1. In pen write "Magic happens when you don't give up, even though you want to."
2. Clay or play-doh sculptures
3. Acrostic poem "Rabbit"
4. Draw a rabbit in a hat
5. Friendship bracelet
6. On a paper plate, label and display 3 different things found on a nature walk.
7. Perth County Farm Safety Association
Special: Using a variety of art materials, design a T-shirt to wear in the sun using the work page found on our website. Include a message on the shirt showing the importance of wearing a shirt when in the sun.
8. Special for 4-H Members only: Make a survival kit in a shoe box comprised of 8 items (no electronics) which would be useful in case of an emergency or natural disaster.

Class 4: Junior Fair - Ages 10-13 (Age as of May 11, 2019)

Section:

1. 3-D paper art (not geometric)
2. 3-D paper art - geometric
3. Draw and colour a Harry Potter character
4. Any "no sew" item
5. Any knit item (can be finger knit)
6. Anything built with Lego (not a kit)
7. Perth County Farm Safety Association
Special: Make a diorama (a model representing a scene with three dimensional figures) that will fit in a shoe box. You can use LEGO bricks, popsicle sticks, etc. Have your farm safety scene show a farm safety message. Type the message on a piece of paper and add it to the box.



8. Special for 4-H Members only: Make a survival kit in a shoe box comprised of 8 items (no electronics) which would be useful in case of an emergency or natural disaster.
